How Do I Reset My MAISD Managed Password?

The first level of login security is using multiple and secure passwords. The second is changing all your password regularly. You are required to change your password every 60 days the MAISD. This is a good compromise between security and user convenience.

This is the password change process for MAISD hosted accounts.

You need to have a good password in mind.


How Do I Create a Memorable, Secure Password?

Changing your MAISD password is through a do it yourself, self-service site




Click the link provided to begin.

- 1. Enter your identifying information.
- 2. Enter the <u>CAPTCHA</u> information.
- 3. Click Search.

Click Manage My Passwords.


Verify your identity

- 2. Confirm your new password.


